Wolfgang Ischinger assumed his position as Germany's ambassador to the U.S. in July, 2001. Since joining the German Foreign Service in 1975, Mr. Ischinger has served in a variety of positions in the German Foreign Ministry, and participated in a number of international negotiations, including the Bosnian peace talks in Dayton, Ohio. From 1998-2001 he served as deputy Foreign Minister (the highest civil service post in the German Foreign Office). Ambassador Ischinger studied law at the University of Bonn and the University of Geneva and completed his postgraduate studies at Harvard University and the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy in 1973.
